AWARENESS PROGRAM

Educational AWARENESS Programs

Altruism Society Honour Assistance (AsHA) was initiative Educational awareness and campaign in many rural areas school (Habrubil, Nepalpara, dulapra, Kachukata, Gossaigaon etc) under the Gossaigaon block in the Kokrajhar dist.

The Main Objective of our Educational Awareness Programs-

1. To improve the quality of education
2. Motivated Students & Guardians for Education.
3. Decreased Dropouts Rate.
4. Information Right to Education.
5. To provide counseling support to parents, guardians, local community members and mothers on importance of education of their children. This in turn will help to increase the enrollment rate and minimizing the dropout rate.
6. Encourage active involvement of the community, parents and likeminded organizations
7. Make a lasting and sustainable impact on the community by providing contextually relevant education of good quality

Livelihood AWARENESS Program

We the AsHA organization in this year completed three livelihood awareness programs on seasonal crops like- System of Rice Intensification(SRI), Nutrition Garden (N.G), Maize Cultivation etc. In the various villages like – Kachukata, Aminkata, Habrubil, Gossaigaon, Bhaolaguri, Dulapara etc. with women self Help Group (SHGs)

The Main Objective of our Livelihood Awareness Programs

1. Engaging in Livelihood Promotion is to enhance food security of the households by adoption of SRI Principle's increasing yield by 1.5 to 2 times.
2. Also enhance case income of target families by Rs 25,000 to 30,000/- additionally, through intensive vegetable farming, livestock rearing as well as enterprise like vermi compost production.
3. Awareness on scientific method how to use in rules areas.
4. How to use organic fertilizer and what is important of organic fertilizers.
5. Engaging women self help groups in livelihood promotion for women empowerment purpose.



Campaigns & Awareness on COVID19

Before the lockdown we then, Altruism Society Honour Assistance (AsHA) initiative awareness and campaign in many rural areas (Habrubil, Nepalpara, Dulapra, Kachukata, Gossaigaon etc) under the Gossaigaon block in the Kokrajhar dist. Community meeting:

Community meeting is one kind of awareness program. At the time AsHA organized good number of community meetings. This was done through the collaboration with community leader, parents, senior citizen where the discussion was held openly for sharing our mission, identifying problems, sensitizing the parents for role taking in upbringing of their children and to take special attention in regards to the study of their children.

Home visit:

Home visiting programs are designed and implemented to support families in providing an environment that promotes the healthy growth and development of their children. Sometimes we faced different types of challenges in ensuring presents to send their children to school regularly, enormous effort was given to motivate them. Through home visit program the we were assigned to do door to door home visit for direct interaction with the parents who were encouraged to look after their children sincerely and take education as major responsibility also discussion sustainable livelihood purpose. Knowledge shared on ways to grow scientific way livelihood i.e. agriculture as well as livestock rearing.

Lesson Learnt

It was good advantage for us having built up good rapport with local community including parents, guardian, school authorities and wider network with different donors can create platform of working space for the welfare of children and local development. Through training and exposure visit our staff gained working and management skills useful ever for the future of the organization and society.

Mission- To empower rural community by stream lining education and sustainable livelihood

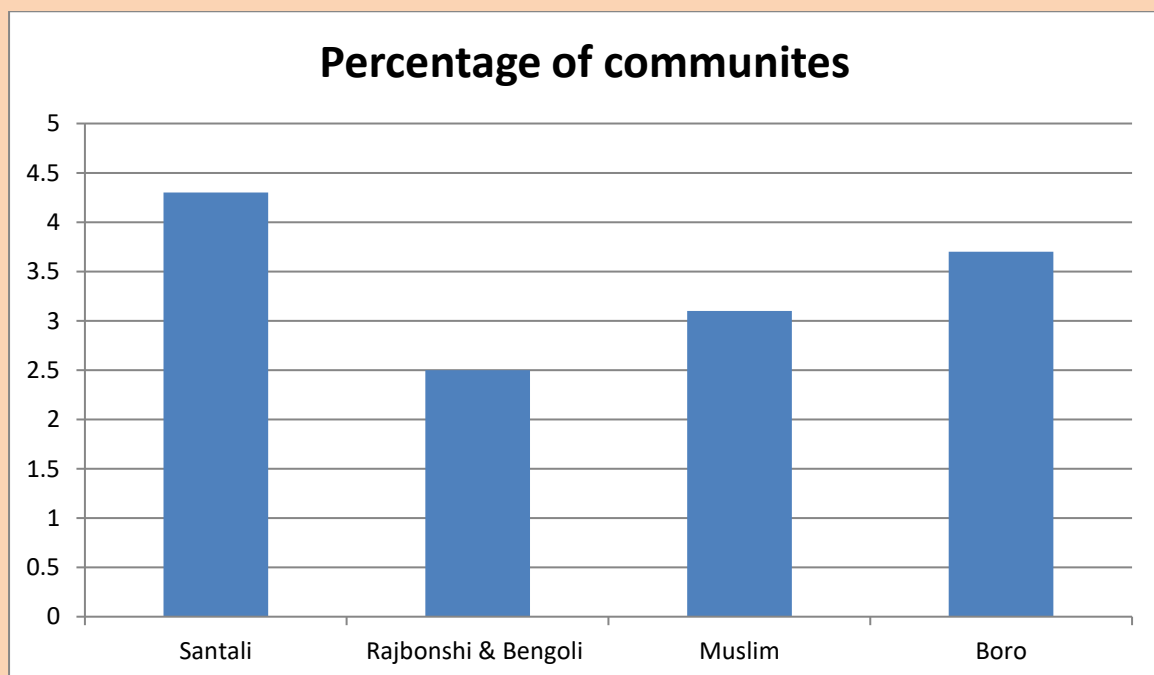
Objective-

Lots of Santali are land less in our working areas also the Santali doesn't have cognizable access to education and income generating activates.
